## CUNY+ Highlights

Select a **single CUNY library** to search, or search the entire CUNY+ catalog. Find journal titles and reserve books more easily by using these specialized CUNY+ options.

**Basic Search** screen offers several search options. Search the top box by keyword in all fields, or search in author, title, or subject fields. Search the bottom box to browse by keyword in the author, title, subject, or number fields.

**Guided Search** screen (not shown) offers a menu for combining keywords or phrases and for using date, language, location, or format (book, periodical, music, map, visual material).

**My Account** screen allows users to check personal library records and to renew and request books online. Requests allowed only for items delivered from one campus to another or for items currently in use. Use My Account/Search History to customize periodic e-mail alerts containing newly added CUNY+ titles of interest.

**E-mail or save** records, first select them with a check mark.

## Other Library Services

**Full Text Journals** Most of the 25,000+ e-journals indexed in 100+ databases are not represented in the CUNY+ catalog. Using the library Web site Full Text Journals link, find a journal title, and link to the database hosting it.

**Remote Access** Download and install Citrix or VPN. A Graduate Center photo ID with a library barcode allows off-campus access to CUNY-wide databases. Click exactly on the house icon in the library databases list, and then enter your library barcode number at the prompt. See [library.gc.cuny.edu/info/remote.asp](http://library.gc.cuny.edu/info/remote.asp) for more details.

**Borrowing** With a current CUNY Graduate center photo ID, students/faculty may borrow any number of books from this library for 3/6 weeks with 3 or 6 renewals unless the item is on hold for another borrower. Graduate Center affiliates may borrow from all CUNY libraries except the law school. Reserve material is usually for library use only; photocopying is available. CUNY students may borrow reserve books 2 hours before the library closes, due 1 hour after the library opens the following day. Overdue fines accrue at \$.10/day to the value of the book; overdue reserve material is fined at \$1.20/hour; overdue requested books at \$1.00/day.

ILL GC affiliates may request books unavailable through CUNY+ and articles unavailable at the GC Library through Interlibrary Loan. Use WorldCat for unmediated (fastest) book ILL. Reference librarians offer Metro Referral Cards to students for on-site access to unique materials in most New York Metropolitan Area libraries.
