



## Finding Ph.D. Dissertations and Master's Theses

### Dissertation Abstracts Full Text

- From the URL above, select Databases and then Dissertation Abstracts.
- CUNY Ph.D. dissertations from 1997 are available in full text in Dissertation Abstracts, free to Graduate Center users. CUNY Ph.D. dissertations from 1965 to the present are indexed in Dissertation Abstracts. Use the school code 0046 for CUNY titles.
- Other institutions' dissertations are indexed in Dissertation Abstracts with free access to the first 24 pages of dissertations from 1997 to the present.
- Order dissertations via Interlibrary Loan (for free or \$5 fee) or for a via Dissertation Abstracts for \$27+.
- Search bound volumes of Dissertation Abstracts 1965 -1980, on the library's second floor, to supplement online searches.
- Find additional non-US dissertations at [www.crl.edu](http://www.crl.edu).

### CUNY Ph.D. Dissertations in Hard Copy

- Reading copies of all CUNY dissertations are shelved in the first floor Dissertation Reading Room, 1989-present, or in the reference area on the second floor, 1965-1988.
- Dissertations are color-coded by department and shelved chronologically and then by author within each year. Microfilm copies are also available.
- Cataloging of CUNY dissertations is underway in CUNY+ and WorldCat. Dissertations from 1965 to 1985 and 1988 to the present are in CUNY+, with 1986-1987 in progress. WorldCat contains records for most CUNY Ph.D. dissertations from 1975 to the present, excluding 1986-1987.
- Find dissertations in CUNY+ by author or title and, in some cases, subject. To search by program in CUNY+, do an author search: **city university of new york ph d program in [program name]**. Note the space within ph d.

### CUNY Master's Theses in Hard Copy

- CUNY Master's theses are not included in Dissertation Abstracts or WorldCat.
- CUNY+ lists all Graduate Center Master's in classics, comparative literature, German, liberal studies, linguistics, philosophy, and political science.
- Find Master's theses in CUNY+ by author or title. To search by program, do an author search: **city university of new york masters program in [program name]**.
