## OXFORD ENGLISH DICTIONARY

The electronic version of the second edition (1989) of *The Oxford English Dictionary* is available from any location within the Graduate Center at [www.oed.com](http://www.oed.com) or by going to the library's Web site ([library.gc.cuny.edu](http://library.gc.cuny.edu)) and clicking *Databases*. ### SEARCHING THE OED ONLINE

1. Enter a word in the *Find word* search box to perform a basic search. The resulting display will include pronunciation(s), etymology, quotations tracing its usage, and a date chart for the quotations.
2. Click the *Simple Search* button to search within definitions, etymologies, language names, quotations, quotation authors, etc. Click the *More Options* button for more precise searching.
3. Click the *Advanced Search* button to restrict a search to a specific part of speech and for such options as quotation author, quotation work, etc.

### PRINTING AND E-MAILING

Click the *Print* button for a more economical printing display. Click the *Mail* button to send an entry to yourself or others.

### ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

Full-text articles about etymology and related topics are available from such databases as Academic Search Premier, JSTOR, Project Muse, and ScienceDirect. Citations, abstracts, and links to full text are available from LLBA and Humanities Abstracts.
